1. Development of position/recommendation regarding outside dining for formal Commission review at the March 15, 2022, Regular Meeting – issues for consideration

(1) Does the Parking Commission support the use of public parking spaces for commercial uses?

If “yes” recommendations on the following:

- a. Limited to restaurants or open to other commercial enterprises?
- b. Limited to businesses fronting spaces requested?
- c. Limit on the number of spaces each business may acquire?
- d. Start and end dates?
- e. Fee schedule – monthly or space/season?
- f. Parking Commission public hearing on each applicant for recommendation to the City Council?

2) Recommendations/concerns/input on issues to be addressed by City Staff:

- Barricades should be water filled to allow quick adjustment, if needed.
- Plastic barricades shall be yellow or orange.
- Barricades shall have reflective material on all surfaces facing traffic.
- Barricades shall be maintained by the applicant and not the city.
- Applicants shall paint any street markings that were not accessible during standard city painting schedules due to the barricades being in place.
- Applicants shall remove and reinstall any signage that may need to be moved for use of the spaces.
- Applicants shall obtain a waiver and any insurance requirements from owner whose property fronts the parking spaces.
- Applicant shall obtain insurance to cover the city while using these spaces.
