1) ROLL CALL

Commissioner McManus made a motion to allow Commissioner Buckley to participate in the meeting via telephone. Motion seconded by Vice Chairman Maglaras.

Roll Call Vote: Reynolds – Yes; Maglaras – Yes; Massingham – Yes; McManus – Yes; Karoutas – Yes; DiGregorio – Yes. **APPROVED 6-0**

1) NEW BUSINESS

A) Development of position/recommendation regarding outside dining for formal Commission review at the March 15, 2022, Regular Meeting – issues for consideration.

(1) Does the Parking Commission support the use of public parking spaces for commercial uses?

The Commission voted 4-3 on its support for use of public parking spaces for commercial use. (Maglaras, McManus, Massingham, and Karoutas voted yes; Reynolds, Buckley and DiGregorio voted no.)

The Commission discussed various elements on drafting a policy for the use of parking spaces by downtown businesses, primarily for restaurant outdoor dining. The Commission discussed time frames for such use, along with application procedures, and fees. With its input, the Commission directed staff to write a policy recommendation, which the Commission will vote on at its regular meeting on March 15, 2022.
