

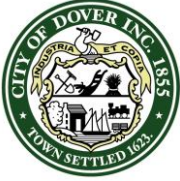

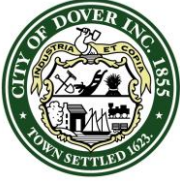
A. Operating Rules

- 1. City attorney indicated that we need to first adopt operating rules for the committee as a whole, which include the description of how subcommittees will function

7. New Business

A. Recreation department – skate park

- 1. Presentation from Gary Bannon of the Rec Department
 - a. City is building a new skatepark in Guppy Park behind the Jenny Thompson Pool
 - b. Current plan is for two phases of the project, to result in custom-designed concrete skate park
 - c. Had conversation with the Arts Commission to locate a graffiti wall on site, and hopefully well-integrated into the park
 - d. (Some discussion with members of the Arts Commission present, moved to section 7b below)
- 2. Darren moves to support the establishment of a graffiti wall at the new skate park within Phase 1
 - a. Discussion on waiting until a more specific proposal is available
 - b. Darren withdrew motion
 - c. Rick will follow up with Gary to specifically request estimate of what could be done, along with the cost and material needs involved



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B. Arts commission – graffiti walls

1. If certain areas are dense with tagging, we could seek to locate the graffiti wall there
2. Winwood, Miami Graffiti Museum has an annual event at the Winwood Walls
3. Ideally would want more than one wall, potentially three. Could be used as sound barriers as well if placed well
4. Different material options possible, like the metal material currently used on the pool building, which will be easy to paint on. The walls shouldn't just be one flat surface either, varied shape will lend itself towards more interesting art
5. The walls should be whitewashed roughly once per year
6. The city could start a photo album somewhere to preserve images of the artwork right before the wall gets whitewashed again
