Statements shall be limited to five (5) minutes unless otherwise extended by the JBC chairperson, with the approval of the Joint Building Committee.

All citizens are permitted to place items on the agenda through written application to the Chair of the Joint Building Committee at least one week prior to the meeting date. Citizen items will require a formal motion and a second by seated members to bring the item to the floor for debate.
