- Motion to approve made by S. Sylvia. Seconded by M. Herrick. Vote U/A.

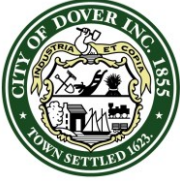
3. Graffiti Management on the Trail
