3. Overview of Completed Outreach Efforts

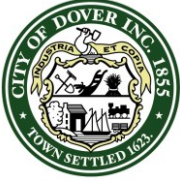
E. Bassegio provided an overview of the completed outreach efforts as part of the Distinctly Dover project with a brief presentation that included photos and examples. Outreach efforts included City-distributed communications, tabling events, a virtual outreach session, a series of “Vision on the Go” visioning sessions, a “drop-in” event day for sharing the draft vision pillars, and multiple online polls.

4. Draft Vision

Members were provided copies of the draft Vision Chapter update, as created by Resilience Planning and CJW Consulting. Two versions of the draft Vision Chapter update were created and provided, one version that includes all resident and stakeholder feedback as an appendix and another version without the feedback appendix.

Members reviewed the draft Vision Chapter update and discussed their feedback and edits that will be incorporated into the draft.
