A. Toter Size Combinations

Moore shared some information about other towns and what they are using for toter sizes for both trash and recycling. The most popular size seems to be the 64-gallon toter for both trash and recycling. Other towns offer an option of a 48-gallon toter for trash only to senior citizens and disabled persons, however they would have to petition to get a 48-gallon toter.

Dinzeo shared everyone should start at 64-gallon toters, then after 30 days as long as they meet the qualifications, they can petition for the 48-gallon trash toter.

Kemp shared that all residents should be made aware of the addition option to petition for the smaller size trash toter. He also stressed the importance of educating residents upfront.

Dinzeo suggested at some point putting a mailer about the future toters in with the utility bills.

Moore shared there are 29 private roads in Dover that are completely on their own. The private roads that are currently grandfathered in for trash pick-up as well as the small downtown businesses would need toters. We also will pick up for buildings with 4 units or less. He also shared those buildings with 5-8 units are viewed as businesses, so they would be on their own as far as trash and recycling. Moore did share that once the toters are linked to an address, they will stay at that location.
