The cities of Dover, Rochester, and Somersworth (the TriCities) are working cooperatively with the Strafford County Commissioners' Office to support a cold weather safety plan for county residents. On behalf of the TriCities, Strafford County agrees to administer a contract awarded through a competitive bid process to operate the Willand Warming Center during the winter of 2024-2025.

- The cities of Dover and Rochester agree to each transfer, not to exceed \$70,000, to Strafford County to fund this contract.
- Strafford County agrees to support this contract with funds received from the NH DHHS Cold Weather Shelter program, as available.

In addition,

- The city of Somersworth agrees to provide in-kind municipal support for the duration of this effort in the form of law enforcement, fire/EMS, and health and safety services.
- The TriCity Emergency Management Directors agree to provide direction regarding activation thresholds.
- Strafford County agrees to provide contract management and vendor oversight under the general terms of the collaboratively developed RFP between Strafford County and the Subcontractor.
- Strafford County agrees to collaborate with TriCity leadership regarding any changes to the scope of service in the Strafford County – Subcontractor MOU for Willand Warming Center operations.
- Strafford County agrees to require the Subcontractor to name the TriCities as additional insured entities entitled to all indemnification terms identified in the Strafford County – Subcontractor MOU.
