Dana Lynch, 36 Cardinal Dr, questioned whether or not the subdivision he lives in would be grandfathered into the solid waste program. He also asked the Council to consider the impact to all residents of the City regardless of the type of street they live on.

Jesse Andrew Galt, 48 Prospect St, spoke on the extension of the solid waste contract and the proposed flat fee.

Sam Hewitt, 5 Maple St, expressed support for the automatic pick up service. Mr. Hewitt spoke about the impact on multi-family homes, and the importance of enforcement.

Ray Bardwell, Spur Rd, expressed concern about the cost of the program.
