2. FIRE

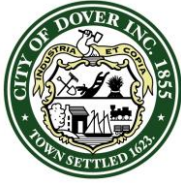
Fire Chief and Emergency Management Director Perry Plummer gave a PowerPoint presentation to the Council on the proposed FY2026 Fire Department budget.
