E. Ryherd offered to coordinate on potential scouting projects.

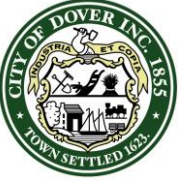
E. Bassegio reported that T. Ryde provided a detailed overview of locations where the turtle wayfinding markers between the Transportation Center and Fourth Street need to be replaced or touched up. This includes areas where markers are missing due to recent sidewalk reconstruction on Grove Street.

b. Trail Improvements

Members discussed that the fence between Scenic Drive and Folsom Street has been replaced, and agreed that a turtle wayfinding marker should be added to the fence.

Members reviewed snow removal practices on the trail, including the sections that are regularly cleared.

Members reviewed recommended areas of improvement on the trail, including extending fencing on the pedestrian bridge, repairing the boardwalk near the underpass, and fixing fencing in the underpass area that seems to have been damaged by the Rt. 16 construction work.

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Members proposed a contest to create a new mural for the section of the trail behind the Beckwith Ballfields. The discussion included requesting draft submissions, selecting a winner, and allocating funds for materials and a prize.

Motion to expend up to \$350.00 towards an art contest for the trail made by S. Sylvia. Seconded by B. Hardwick. Vote: U/A.

c. TAP Extension Phases IV-A and IV-B

e. Outreach and Trail Events

E. Ryherd suggested exploring alternative methods for knotweed removal, such as drying it out, rather than bagging and disposing of it.
