Shawn Mickelonis, Regent Dr, spoke against the edit to the Council Rules that would limit public forum from 5 minutes to 3 minutes.

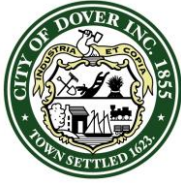
6. NEW BUSINESS
