Apologies for the delay in response, we have been quite busy gearing up for our Winter Show happening on Sunday and lost track of this item. Please see below the requests from the band. Is there further details concerning the cost of the Red's Good Vibes unit for lease. There is also the question as to where this unit could be housed while in off-season, etc.

Large freezer

Large beverage cooler

Large fridge

Multi-level pizza warmer

A couple large air fryers (safe for fries/burgers, etc)

A lot of overhead cabinets and under cabinet storage.

Storage racks for setting up microwaves, popcorn, pretzel, etc equipment.

Shelving on the concessions doors that open wide to put condiments on for people to serve onto their food on their way out.
Hanging drop down baskets would be nice for candy storage that can be up and out of the way but easy access to reach up and grab.
Indoor safe grills that plug in, close, and control smoke.
Is there a possible option for an outdoor grille area with a picnic table setup?

Good news, the athletics project has kept close to schedule this winter. Still too early to say whether we will have a field ready for play this fall.

We do need to make some decisions in the next month about the concessions building. Fundamentally it comes down to, will we have more of a commercial-grade kitchen with a grill and frialator requiring a hood; or more of a basic space?

One decision we did make was to NOT run a gas line to the building. If you need gas, we can install a tank.

If there are upgrades from a basic box, we also need to come to an understanding about who will pay for what. It would helpful if you could build an equipment list of everything that needs to in the box.

The JBC is meeting on March 11 at 5:30 at City Hall. May I ask that you put your heads together and determine what you want incorporated into the design? Can't promise we can accommodate every request.

Finally, I am told the Reds Good Vibes food trailer, which the city owns, is available and could be for sale (or lease?) at a very reasonable price. This could be a work-around on the grill/hood question.
