5A: Winter Parking

Community Services Director John Storer is requesting additional locations be added to the one-sided seasonal parking restriction as well as one removal and one housekeeping amendment.

Resolution: Recommend to City Council.

Amend 141-48. Schedule I: No Parking at Any Time by adding the following locations for the Dec. 1 to April 1 restriction.

Add:

Park Street – easterly side, from the intersection with Ham Street, northerly to the intersection with Ham Street.

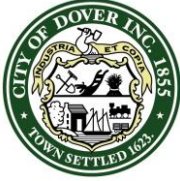
Roosevelt Avenue – northerly side, from the driveway of 15 Roosevelt Avenue, westerly to the intersection with Horne Street.

Laura Lane

- easterly side, from the intersection with Long Hill Road, northerly to the end of the street to include the dirt parking pad at the end of the road.
- westerly side, from the driveway of 18 Laura Lane, northerly to the end of the road.

Remove

Industrial Park Drive – easterly, then southerly side from the westernmost driveway from 89 Industrial Park Drive (Eversource Pole No. 305/12B) northerly, then easterly to the driveway of 115 Industrial Park Drive (Eversource Pole No. 305/15BS).



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Amend

From: Third Street – southerly side, from the intersection with Chestnut Street, westerly to the intersection with Grove Street

To: Third Street - southerly side, from the intersection with Grove Street, westerly to the intersection with Frances Drive.

5B: Parking Space Transfer/sale – Orchard Street Lot

Chris Parker – Deputy City Manager

Resolution: Recommend to City Council.

Exchange ten (10) deeded spaces currently controlled by Summit Land Development in the Orchard Street parking lot for five (5) spaces in the lot adjacent to 83 Washington Street (Thirsty Moose) while adding 5 permits to the current agreement with Summit Land.

5C: Permit Parking

Resolution: Recommend to City Council.

Amend 141-52. Schedule M: Parking Permits Zones

Add:

Chestnut Street – both sides, two hour limit parking areas as designated by 141-49.B, from the intersection with Third Street, northerly to the intersection with Sixth Street.

Washington Street – northerly side, from the intersection with Chestnut Street, westerly to the intersection with Green Street.

Rates for above permits:

Chestnut Street - \$35/month (initial limit 5)

Washington Street - \$30/month (initial limit 3)
