Resolution Re: Full Time Teen Center Operation

WHEREAS: The City Council desires to open the Teen Center full time and throughout the summer; and

WHEREAS: The City Manager presents that Dover is receiving a Department of Justice (DOJ) Grant of approximately \$223,000.00 to be used on non-budgeted teen activities; and

WHEREAS: The amount of funding in the Grant will provide enough revenues to keep the Teen Center open full time for three (3) years; and

WHEREAS: The City of Dover is requesting approval from the DOJ to hire a full time Teen Center Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND DOVER CITY COUNCIL THAT:

If the DOJ approves the use of the funding for hiring a full time Teen Center Director, the City Manager is hereby directed to use those funds for the Teen Center Director position for the next three (3) fiscal years;

AND, FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED;

The City Manager shall begin to operate the Teen Center on a full time basis immediately upon passage of this resolution and approval from the DOJ.
