Meeting called to order by the Chair, Glenn Grasso at 6:04 P.M. A short presentation of why street names and numbering must occur was done by staff. Following is pertinent to each of the streets being considered for renaming:

1) SPUR RD EXT

1 of 4 properties was represented at the meeting and a second was heard from by E-mail. Will receive new street name and a renumbering of one property (#4) to an odd number that is less than 15. This is pending the selection of a street name.

2) TOLEND RD EXT

1 of 4 properties was represented; that being the Bastianellis of #14 who are the longest-tenured residents (41 years). They preferred a new street name over the alternative to make it part of Sunhawk Lane. Will receive new street name and a renumbering of one property (#358) that should change to an odd number greater than 15. This is pending selection of a street name.

3) BELLAMY RD (NORTH OF KNOX MARSH)

2 residents in attendance presented a petition (copy on file in TAC folder in Planning/Police), signed by representatives of 9 of the 12 properties, requesting **CHANDLER WAY**. The Chandler family is said to have lived in this neighborhood and on this street for 4 generations. House numbers remain the same. As it does not conflict with any current name, this one can be added without delay to the four that are also awaiting draft of a resolution to forward to the Council as follows:

LONGHILL RD EXT to SANDY LANE
HORNE COURT to BERRY BROOK COURT
VARNEY RD EXT to LAURA LANE
MAST RD EXT to LEATHERS LANE

4) REDDEN ST EXT

Little more than a half dozen of the 39 affected properties were represented, but they came from all segments of the neighborhood and all were in favor of the City's proposal. The proposal is to drop the "EXT" from REDDEN ST, which will now run the entire length from Glenwood to Horne to dead end. This is ready to be added to the Council resolution. #1 - #10 REDDEN EXT will drop the EXT and keep same house numbers. #1 - #59 REDDEN ST will need to be renumbered. This renumbering will correct the odd-even alternation that occurs now and clear up some duplicate number confusion in the area of Horne Street. The drawback is that most of the renumbered properties will assume a new number that was previously in use for a different family. This will have the highest potential for misdirected mail. Staff recommended that this resolution be set to take effect on a specific date instead of the usual "takes effect upon passage" of the Council.
