

# Arena Commission

## Minutes of April 18, 2006

Meeting called to order 7:06 PM at the Sam Allen Conference Room.

- I. Minutes from March 21, 2006 were read. Motion was made by Ron Huml to accept the Minutes as read. Seconded by Gary Gilmore. Voted and accepted.
- II. Financial Statements were presented by Gary Bannon for the period ending February 2006. Revenue for the month was \$89,898 with expenses at \$89,190. Motion was made by Ron Huml to accept the Financial Statements as read. Seconded by Gary Gilmore. Voted and accepted.
- III. Recreation Director's Report was given by Gary Bannon. He talked about the summer brochure being distributed to the public. Working on vending bid, we will be taking over the entire beverage vending for the city and snack machine will be managed by a vending company. Motion was made by Ron Huml to accept the Recreation Superintendent's report as read. Seconded by Gary Gilmore. Voted and accepted.
- IV. Arena Managers Report was given by Pat McNulty. Motion was made by Ron Huml to accept the Arena Managers report as read. Seconded by Gary Gilmore. Voted and accepted.
- V. Program Supervisor's report was given by Brian Wilson. Brian talked about our 3 on 3 spring league that will be starting at the end of April. The program has four divisions that range from mini-mites to Peewee/Bantam and they all have good attendance. Adult Intro class has 28 participants, which is the highest enrollment for the class. Youth Intro to Hockey will be starting in May; there are 19 kids enrolled in the class. Also working on getting summer staff for Camp Kool. Motion was made by Joe Nicolella to accept the Program Supervisor's report as read. Seconded by Gary Gilmore. Voted and accepted.
- VI. Marketing status report- Gary Bannon gave Colleen's report; he talked about the renewed dasher contract with Days Inn and Granite State College. April is a busy month for events; so far we've held the Flyball Dog Show and Skate with the Easter Bunny, both events went well. Other events for the month include the WERZ kids Fest and the Home Show. For the month of May the following events will be at the Arena, Job Fair 32 and Maximum Velocity. Motion was made by Ron Huml to accept the Marketing status report as read. Seconded by Gary Gilmore. Voted and accepted.
