

**MINUTES  
SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION  
FEBRUARY 17, 2006**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** On a motion by Judy, seconded by Ed the minutes were approved. The vote was unanimous.

**MONTHLY UPDATE:** The update was discussed and approved. The General Fund Balance went down an additional \$19,000 by paying an unpaid invoice, from 2003, to Waste Management. Gary requested that the recycling tonnages/numbers be added to the monthly update.

**RECYCLING CENTER:** Christmas trees were chipped at the center and 30+ yards of chips were brought to Barrington free of charge. There has been a positive response to the construction debris scale staying open year round. Gary asked Mike to consider opening accounts for residents who regularly use the construction debris scale; Mike will look into how and if this can be done.

**CURBSIDE COLLECTION:**

**a. Tonnages, Pinard vs. WMI:** At Mike's request, this item has been tabled until the next meeting.

**OLD BUSINESS: Private Residential Areas (sample letter will be provided):** The Commission reviewed the letter that will be sent to the affected residents/homeowner associations. As there has been no Councilor appointed to represent the Commission, the Commission decided that Dave would write a letter to Mayor Scott Myers, copying Mike Joyal-City Manager and the City Council, informing them of this situation. A copy of the letter to the residents and the January 19, 2006 minutes will be included for review. This letter will inform the Councilors of the private street changes in their ward. The Commission feels the Council should know before the letter goes out to the affected residents so they can be prepared for questions.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Mike let the Commission know he, in a letter to The Ways and Means Committee, is supporting HB 634. Joseph Nicolella joins the Commission as the third alternate.

**ADJOURNMENT:** The meeting was adjourned at 7:10. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 16, 2006 at 6:00 pm.
