

**MINUTES
SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION
MAY 18, 2006**

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by Judy seconded by Gary the minutes were approved. The vote was unanimous.

MONTHLY UPDATE: No update available.

RECYCLING CENTER: Beginning July 10, 2006 the hours at the center will be as follows: Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 8 am to 5 pm; Saturday 8 am to 4 pm; Monday and Friday closed. Sunday hours are seasonal (the third Sunday in April through the third Sunday in June and again beginning the third Sunday in September through the third Sunday in November) 8 am to 4 pm. Mike Moore surveyed five other communities similar in population and comparative for capacity. Mike found Dover's Recycling Center to be open more hours than any of the communities surveyed.

Center employees are busy bringing / removing dumpster containers to different parts of the City where residents were flooded. These containers will allow those residents to dispose of their damaged items at no charge.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION:

a. Bag Prices: Due to additional tonnage, disposal increases, and other increasing expenses the bag prices will be increased. As of July 1, 2006 the thirty-gallon bags will be \$2; fifteen-gallon bags will be \$1.35 and bulky item tags \$4. The Commission Chair will contact Councilor Turner regarding the increase.

OLD BUSINESS: The Private Road Liability Waiver was discussed along side the City ordinance revision. The Commission feels the two documents aren't saying the same thing and ask that the language in the two documents mirror each other.
