SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION
OCTOBER 19, 2006**

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes were approved on a motion by Doug and seconded by Jim; with the amendment that Councilor Harvey Turner was present. The vote was unanimous.

MONTHLY UPDATE: Report not available. The Bag and Tag sales report was handed out and reviewed.

RECYCLING CENTER:

a. Funding for remote office at the center: Mike had requested funding to build an office at the center. After much discussion, it was decided that Mike would look at all of the funding options and bring them to the next meeting. Also, the Commission will consider pursuing funding as a budget item.

b. Charge for propane tanks: Prices were renegotiated between NRRA and Blue Rhino Inc. to stay the same, therefore there will be no need, at this time, to charge for tanks received at the center.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION:

a. Curbside Leaf Collection: The collection is scheduled for the following weeks on the regular scheduled trash day. October 30th – November 3rd and again November 13th – November 17th

OLD BUSINESS: Household Hazardous Waste Collection brought in 313 people for a total of 84 drums of hazardous waste. The four towns/cities that participated were Dover, Madbury, Lee and Rollinsford.

NEW BUSINESS: Doug Kemp, NH DES inspected the recycling center on Thursday, October 5, 2006. Doug will send a copy of his report to the City of Dover once completed.
