SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes were approved on a motion by Doug and seconded by Jim; the vote was unanimous.

MONTHLY UPDATE: Flood related charges were discussed. The Fund Balance was discussed. The Commission would like clarification on the actual revenue vs. projected revenue, and their comparison to the graph showing current Solid Waste balances.

RECYCLING CENTER: The hours were discussed in terms of usage. The current hours at the center are Monday and Friday closed, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 8am to 5pm and Saturday 8am to 4pm. The Commission would like to do a count on how many people actually use the center from 2pm to 5pm. This count would tell the Commission if the center could be open fewer hours in the winter when the usage is lower.

On the request of a resident, Ed purposed selling leaf bags at cost. After much discussion the Commission concluded the City of Dover could not sell the bags cheaper than businesses that buy in bulk.
