

# TAC MEETING NOTES May 22, 2006

## I. Minutes

The minutes from the April 24, 2006 meeting were approved by unanimous vote.

## II. Old Business

- a. Ordinance changes to Community Trail-Tom Fargo requested to speak to the Commission but was not available this evening.

## III. New Business

- a. Transportation Master Plan. Bruce Woodruff handed out excerpts from the Master Plan and Rizzo Report. He reviewed the status of tasks in the current chapter and outlined what was left to do. His recommendation was to finish the current work before beginning on the public process for a revised or new Transportation Chapter. The Chair expressed a desire to schedule public input meetings later this year to gather input on the state of transportation and neighborhoods in anticipation of the future task. No decisions were made.
- b. Trail issue brought by Tom Fargo. Since he is out of town, this issue will be added to the next TAC agenda, however, both Police and Planning discussed the need to revise Dover Code Chapter 131 and 166 in anticipation of the Community Trail for issues such as no alcohol, no motorized vehicles, and hours of operation so that enforcement may take place. The issue of police enforcement on sections of the Trail that are not owned in fee by the City is covered by NH RSA 215-A: 16.
