Chairman Cole opened the workshop at 6:30 pm.

1. Presentation by the UNH Survey Center on the City of Dover Master Plan Telephone Survey

Christopher Parker explained that this survey has been published for the general public. It can be found on the City's web site. He introduced Andy Smith, from the UNH Survey Center.

Andy Smith did a power point presentation on the results of the telephone survey and went over the major findings. The overall conclusion is that Dover is a nice place to live.

Ron Cole felt that the responses tell the Board what is needed to be done in the City and it is also a pat on the back for some of the things that the Board has done.

Christopher Parker added the questions have been on the City's website for the last two weeks. They can be downloaded and submitted to the Planning Dept., so far none were received. If anyone wants to respond it will be kept separate from the telephone survey to keep it scientific and preserve the integrity of the survey. They are interested on any feedback.

Steve Bird explained that the report was e-mailed to the City Councilors and they were invited to attend if they could. The report is a draft and the Planning staff will go through it for errors. The Library has a copy of the draft. The study will be finalized in the next 2 weeks.
