1. Approval of Minutes

2. Monthly Update: April and May financial reports were discussed. The \$12,000 that was taken out and used for the McConnell Center hasn't been put back in the fund balance to date. The Commission will be looking at the electronic and freon item fees for a possible increase.

A. **Financial data:** End of year financial data is not available.

B. **Tonnage report:** Mike handed out a tonnage report showing both curbside trash and recycling. There are questions on some of the totals Mike will clear up for the next meeting.

3. Recycling Center: Councilor Harvey Turner requested displaying a map of the layout of the center, in the trailer, at the center for residents to view.

Pinard Waste Systems is sending an electrician to do the wiring for the paper compactor. Mike discussed leaving a 6-yard container at the center for books once the compactor is up and running.

The center hauled 220 tons of brush in May, and 150 tons in June. Also in June 84 tons of yard waste and 64 tons of wood.
