The City of Dover Transportation Advisory Commission (TAC) convened a Neighborhood Meeting on possible changes to street addresses and/or street names mandated by the E-911 system for the following streets: Long Hill Road Extension, Mast Road Extension, Redden Street Extension, Varney Road Extension, Bellamy Road (north of Knox Marsh Rd.). There were three TAC members, staff from Police, Fire, Planning and the Post Office, and fourteen residents from the four street neighborhoods in attendance. Officials from the Post Office, Police and Fire Department and Building Official's Office (Planning) made a brief presentation, using map products, explaining why this is necessary. After the presentation, staff answered all questions from the public. There was general discussion regarding street name ideas for each street, when the change would occur, and what impacts it would have on individuals. Residents present from Mast Rd. Ext. expressed a unified desire to rename their street to Leathers Lane. Varney Rd. Ext. residents present discussed the need for them to get together after this meeting to discuss what name they wanted and that they would get back to City staff with their preference. There was extensive discussion regarding Long Hill Rd. Ext. regarding
