## CLASS VI ROADWAYS AD HOC COMMITTEE MINUTES

Members present: Doug Steele, Dean Trefethen, Rob Schneider, Paul Valisch, Eric Hageman, Betsey McNaughten, Cheryl Niles, and Don Andolina.

Meeting called to order at 5:06pm.

Discussion was attempted on Hanson Way, but apparently letters to abutters did not get sent and without Woodruff present there's no way to confirm. In general the committee feels that the road should probably be discontinued. Further discussion will be postponed to the next meeting.

The committee continued discussion on Old Garrison Road and David Tuttle Road and reviewed a draft of recommendations for the roads. These recommendations have Old Garrison Road from Spruce Lane to the Towle property remaining as Class VI, and all of David Tuttle remaining as Class VI. McNaughten suggested that it would be easier for Fish and Game to keep their land secure if the portion of David Tuttle east of Old Garrison was discontinued. After discussion the committee felt this would be a good idea but wanted to inform the immediate abutters of this proposal and get their input before making a final decision. Letters will be sent out asking for responses by the October 16 meeting. Other possibilities of making certain sections a community trail or similar were also discussed but dismissed as not being practical.

Next discussed was Cold Spring Road and whether it is a Class VI road or a private road. Steele presented evidence that it was a private road and that the city should stop doing any maintenance on it. After discussion the committee agreed it was a private road. Trefethen will notify the city manager of this finding to have the city send a notice to land owners along the road that there will not be maintenance this winter or at anytime in the future.

Concerning Green Hill Road, Niles indicated that there has been no real progress.

Citizen's Forum: Rick Hebbard raised the issue of a road/driveway off Back River Road just south of Wingate Lane, questioned the status of Old Rollinsford Rd beyond the doctor's office buildings, and also mentioned High Ridge Drive Extension.

Future meeting dates were set for October 9, 16 and 23, also November 1 and 20.
