1. The agenda gives the false impression that Horne Court is a dead end street. If Horne Court was a dead end street then the issue of commercial traffic would not exist. The Council should be aware that the owners of the street want to make it a dead end street. They are awaiting the legal review as requested by the TAC to determine if there is something that keeps them from doing so. It is the expectation that the restriction of commercial traffic will eliminate the use of Horne Court for access to the industrial complex and force the use of the designated Horne Street entrance.
2. The council should be aware that restriction of commercial traffic on Horne Court is only one of many issues that the residents have regarding the industrial use. Of those issues are health, safety, environment, disturbing the peace, harassment, and dispute over property lines.
3. The residents of Horne Court will present their full list of concerns at the public hearing of this case.
4. We request that you move forward with this as swiftly as possible since there has been very limited assistance or cooperation with the Planning Department on this matter over the past few months.
