SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION  
OCTOBER 20, 2005**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** On a motion by Jim, seconded by Councilor Perry the minutes were approved. The vote was unanimous.

**MONTHLY UPDATE:** The Commission feels the computer / recycling bin funds should not be on the same report as the Vehicle Trust Fund and is requesting a different report for these items.

**RECYCLING CENTER:**

**Update on operations:** Starting January 1, 2006 plastic food containers #3-7 will be recyclable. This will be advertised through the website, channel 22 and Fosters. A change in hours of operations will begin on January 1, 2006; this will also be advertised. Vincent Turcotte is the centers new truck driver; Vincent has been employed by the City of Dover for eighteen years.

NE Recovery had 62 people, from New Hampshire communities, tour the center.

**Results of Hazardous Waste Day, September 24<sup>th</sup>:** Care Environmental collected Household Hazardous Waste from 9am until 1 pm. Participating communities included: Dover, Madbury, Lee, Rollinsford, and Nottingham, with a total of 356 residents participating. Glass and plastics can now be mixed at center.

**Christmas Tree:** The center will start accepting tress on December 26, 2005.

**CURBSIDE COLLECTION:**

**Update on Trash and Recycling pickup:** No issues.

**Leaf Collection:** Pinard Waste Systems has two trucks dedicated to leaf collection. Using the trash route, the leaves will be collected during the weeks of October 24<sup>th</sup> –28<sup>th</sup>, November 7<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup>, and November 21<sup>st</sup> –25<sup>th</sup>.
