

**MINUTES
SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION
NOVEMBER 17, 2005**

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by Councilor Perry, seconded by Doug the minutes were approved. The vote was unanimous.

MONTHLY UPDATE: The Commission would like a report on the cost of the construction debris. The Commission feels in order to get an accurate cost they need to track departments within the City that are utilizing the construction debris without compensation.

RECYCLING CENTER:

Update on operations: RMG Enterprises will be collecting the recycled computers from the center as a result of End of Life Electronics suspending their operations. The freon extraction is a slow process and can only be done at the center in conjunction with outside services. As a result of Advanced Recycling increasing prices Interstate Refrigeration will be extracting freon for the center. Mike will set up a time to demonstrate how the freon extraction process works for anyone interested.

Update on leaf pickup: Curbside leaf collection is going smoothly. Waste Management has increase their tonnage price from \$11.20 to \$55 per ton as a result leaves will no longer be brought there. The leaves will be brought to Earth Tenders located in Farmington, NH for \$16 a ton. This will also affect the third party landscapers. Mike will notify Waste Management that the City of Dover will no longer pay for these landscapers to use their facility.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION:

Update on Trash and Recycling pickup: No issues.

NEW BUSINESS: Mike will send out a letter to the landscapers notifying them that starting December 1, 2005 they will no longer be able to use Waste Managements facility they will have to use Earth Tenders.

OLD BUSINESS: Dave gave a slide presentation at the recycling conference on Wednesday, November 16th; explaining Dover's bag and tag program and the origin of the recycling program.

Private residential plan pickup issues: It has been determined that there are 472 homes on the private road list. A meeting with Mike Joyal, Doug Steele, Steve Stance, Steve Bird and Mike Moore will be set up to discuss the next step.
