APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes were not read.

MONTHLY UPDATE: Was not discussed.

RECYCLING CENTER:

Update on operations: Starting January 4, 2006 the center will no longer be open on Wednesday's. Also starting on January 3, 2006 plastics #3 thru #7 will be accepted at the center. Advertising will be via, Channel 22, Dover's website also, Public Service Announcements will be sent to Fosters, WOKQ and WTSN to get the new information to the residents.

Update on leaf pickup: A total of 111 tons were picked up curbside.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION:

Update on Trash and Recycling pickup: Historically, Thursday has been the largest trash route. Due to the size of the route, some of Thursday's route will be changed to Tuesday. This change will help balance out the trash routes. A mass mailing will go out to the 242 homes affected by the change. Route changes will begin Monday, January 2, 2006. Mike will notify Councilor Perry.

#3 thru #7 Plastics: Beginning January 4, 2006 plastics #3 thru #7 will be accepted. No plastics larger than 18 gallon will be accepted curbside.

NEW BUSINESS: Due to the bulky item tag price remaining the same for the last six years and disposal cost (price per ton) increasing; Mike is requesting the bulky tag price be increased from \$3 to \$4 per tag as of July 1, 2006.

OLD BUSINESS:

Private residential plan pickup issues: Mike will meet with City Planners and the City Manager to discuss a course of action on December 21, 2005.
