- 1. Approval of Minutes** – There were no minutes available for review.
- 2. Monthly Update:** The monthly update was reviewed by the committee. It was noted that Pinard collection and disposal had not been paid for March as of the date the update was printed.
- 3. Recycling Center:** A discussion began about the cost saving measures being implemented at the center. The members discussed the possibility of removing city dumpsters from the Solid Waste fund and having each city department responsible for paying for their own tonnage charges. Mike will discuss this further with Doug Steele and have an update for the committee at the next meeting. The committee voted to increase the price of the demo debris from .05/lb to .07/lb, instead of .06/lb as initially voted on February 21, 2008. Mike also reported that the deck is being built around the OCC compactor at the center. Councilor DeDe's idea of the construction debris multiple visit pass was discussed further but no recommendations were made by the committee on the idea.
- 4. Curbside Collection:** Mike informed the committee that due to the high cost of oil/plastics, the City of Dover recycling bin price will increase from \$6 to \$7 per bin beginning July 1, 2008. The committee also discussed a possible bag price increase (approximately 10¢ / 30 gallon bag) for the next fiscal year. No recommendation was made.
- 5. Old Business:** The members discussed that the recycling decals would be distributed when vehicles were registered, however, details still need to be clarified.

- 7. Adjournment:** The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 19, 2008.
