Mr. Gaynor, Engineer, gave a summary of his work in connection with the sewer survey for the Industrial Park.

Motion by Farrar, seconded by LaBrie to accept the report as submitted.

Motion by LaBrie, seconded by Crawford that we recommend their acceptance of Route A for the sewer for the Industrial Park.

Motion by DuBois, seconded by Nealley that the City Engineer furnish us with plans of existing line and proposed extensions on the Durham Road.

Motion by Farrar, seconded by Neally to contact Mayor Morrison to clarify the various aspects of the issues concerning the Smith and Bradley cases now in the hands of the City Solicitor.

Motion by McDonald, seconded by Farrar that the request of Edwin M. Paine, Jr. for approval of his home, sewerage system and water supply be accepted and placed on file. This also recommended that a set of subdivision regulations be sent to Mr. Paine so he may submit a plat for subdivision to the Board.
