

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

March 3, 1958

Meeting called to order at 7:45 p.m., March 3, 1958.

Members present: Meserve, Nealley, McDonald, Labrie, Crawford, DuBois, and Fischer.

Motion to dispense with reading of minutes of last meeting.

Letter read and placed on file of Mr. Crangle, State Planning Director.

Motion by Fischer to contact Mayor to set a date to meet with Mr. Crangle for a meeting on Urban Planning Assistance Program.

Motion that secretary write to Mayor referring to his reply to Mr. Fischer on February 17, 1958, regarding the junk yard on Sixth St.

This is to inform you that the Planning Board at no time authorized the erection of a fence around the junk yard on Sixth St.

Motion by DuBois, seconded by Nealley.

Motion unanimous.

A complaint will be file again against the junk yard on Sixth Street. Letter to City Solicitor, copy to Mayor.

Motion by Fischer, seconded by Labrie that we ask Mr. Skinner to come to Dover to talk over his qualifications for Planning Director.

Mile of sewer \$68,000 rough estimate for sewer on Durham Road. About 50 per cent of the lots on this road are occupied.

Motion by Fischer, seconded by McDonald that we get a list of owners of the land of Durham Road to compare it with the names of the petitioners for sewer in the area; to see how many people own land that will be served by this sewer.

Report of Director of Public Works, Water Superintendent and City Engineer relative to Cedarbrook Development.

Group will meet at the site on Thursday, March 6, 1958, to review the proposed Cedarbrook plat.
