

PLANNING BOARD MEETING

SEPTEMBER 8, 1958

A meeting of the Planning Board was held on Monday, September 8, 1958, in the Planning Office, City Hall. Those members present were: Chairman Meserve, Mr. Fischer, Mr. McDonald, Mr. DuBois, Mr. Labrie, Mr. Nealley, Mr. Crawford, and Director Skinner.

Motion by Fischer, seconded by McDonald that we dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting. Vote unanimous.

The Planning Director, R. E. Skinner, gave a report on his activities in regard to a recreational survey being made.

Motion by Labrie, seconded by McDonald, that the petition for water extension on Sixth Street be approved under Ordinance #8. Vote unanimous.

Motion by McDonald, seconded by Nealley, that the petition of Walter and Mary Fischer be directed to the Public Works and Water Departments for a report back to the Planning Board. Vote unanimous.

Motion by DuBois, seconded by Fischer, that the Planning Director write to the Health Officer of Dover to have him take action on Mobilehome installation of Mr. and Mrs. Everett Pitman of the Boston Harbor Road, Dover, N. H. The Health Officer is to advise the Planning Board of the action he is taking and send a copy to the Mayor, City Solicitor, and Planning Board. A copy of the violation is to go to the Mayor and City Solicitor. Vote unanimous.

Monday, September 15, 1958, is the date set for a special meeting to discuss the Comprehensive Plan.

The new Zoning Map was unanimously accepted by the Board.
