

SPECIAL PLANNING BOARD MEETING

SEPTEMBER 15, 1958

A special meeting of the Planning Board was held on Monday, September 15, 1958, in the Planning Office, City Hall. The meeting came to order at 7:55 p.m. Those members present were: Chairman Meserve, Fischer, Nealley, Labrie, Crawford, and Director Skinner.

Motion by Fischer, seconded by Crawford, to suspend the rules in order that Mr. Phillip Keefe could present a 15 minute talk relative to Mr. Wilfred Morin of Morin Street, Dover, New Hampshire.

Motion by Fischer, seconded by Labrie, that the Planning Board recommend not to accept Morin Street as the subdivider, Wilfred Morin, has not complied with subdivision regulations of the City of Dover, and that the Planning Director write to the City Council relative to the above motion. Vote unanimous.

Motion by Labrie, seconded by Nealley, that we dispense with the special meeting relative to the Comprehensive Plan due to the fact that Mr. Keefe spoke for more than one hour regarding Morin Street.

It was agreed that parts of the Comprehensive Plan would be presented at each regular meeting to be discussed for 15 minutes or not over 20 minutes. Motion by Crawford, seconded by Labrie.

Motion to adjourn. Vote unanimous.
