

Regular Monthly Meeting of Planning Board

December 8, 1958

The regular monthly meeting of the Planning Board was held on Monday, December 8, 1958, in the Planning Office. vat A memo from the Mayor to the Planning Board was read regarding the Planning Board budget. Motion by Fischer, seconded by McDonald, that the Mayor be informed that we received a memo relevant to our 1959 budget and that it be recommended that night time meeting be scheduled. Vote unanimous.

7/10 The second order of business was a letter to the Chairman of the Board from the City Solicitor. It was motioned by Farrar, seconded by McDonald, that the Planning Board accept the City Solicitor's letter and place it on file until ~~the next~~ regular meeting and instruct the Planning Director to investigate the contents of the letter and present such findings to the Board. Vote unanimous.

X Motion by Fischer, seconded by Farrar, that the Mayor notify Mr. Kendall of the F. H. A. that the Planning Board would be more than happy to sit down with a representative of his office at a night time meeting convenient to him. Vote unanimous.

The Planning Director submitted a report on survey of mobile-homes within the city.

The Planning Director, at the request of the Board, will make a survey and report to the Board the location and number of trailers not conforming to zoning regulations in the city.

A general discussion was held on the proposed budget for the year 1959.

vat The Planning Director at the request of the Planning Board will write a follow up letter to the Planning Advisory Service for the answer to a question relative to jurisdiction of the Planning Board over the Housing Authority plans.

An executive session was held to discuss the future of the present Planning Director. It was unanimously voted to terminate his services as of January 31, 1959.
