ITEM NO. 1: ROLL CALL:

ON Roll Call the following members were present: Chairman Ouellette, Mr. Adams, Mr. Chick, Mr. Sheldon. Also attending was Mr. Chandler, Planning Director.

ITEM NO. 2: REFERRAL FROM CITY COUNCIL OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION ON BACK RIVER ROAD:

The Planning Director explained to those present the plan of the resolution authorizing sanitary sewer extension on Back River Road. He stated that the plan is to put the sewer line on the east side somewhere in the access lane. He continued that if the City was going to put in a sewer line it should put it in now and pave over it and that it could be done cheaper now than at any other time. He stated that there are very few people on the road that want to tie into it at the present time.

Mr. Adams asked the reason that the people don't want to tie in. Mr. Chick answered that it was the expense.

Mr. Adams then asked how many people would be affected and what per cent of those affected would hook into it.

Mr. Chick answered that around 30 were affected and that probably 10 of these would hook in initially -- 1/3 per cent.

The four members of the Board present voted unanimously to authorize such extension but subject to another vote.

The Planning Director stated that he would call the other members the following day and try and get another vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
