Moment of Silence

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call; Approval of Agenda

Those members present: Chairman Krans, Commissioners Reynolds, Mone, Landry, Bibber and Dunnington. Chairman Krans noted that Boc, Woods and Gilmore were absent. Landry moved seconded by Dunnington to approve the agenda.

Approval of Minutes

May 5, 2005

Landry moved seconded by Reynolds to accept with all in favor.

May 19, 2005

Landry moved seconded by Mone to accept with all in favor.

Review of Draft of Preliminary Report and Cover Letters to State Officials

Chairman Krans indicated the color of the corrections in the preliminary report with red being deletions, yellow are new add-ons and blue items have only been re-numbered.

Krans read the summary of changes on the inside cover of the report.

Krans asked for any corrections stating that section C3-2 should be in bold. Also the footnotes are now grayed out.

Mone asked if the grayed out notes will come off if this charter is approved. Krans says the Secretary of State will decide on this issue. Discussion ensued on the gray notes and it was decided they would be taken out.

Mone moved seconded by Landry to remove gray areas to save confusion and for educational purposes with all in favor.

Mone asked if we will have another public hearing. Krans says on June 9th. There will be a public hearing. If there is a major change after the public hearing then we will add it and send that portion to the 3 departments at the state level for their comment.

Landry is concerned about tweaking the wording.

New/Old Business

June 9th is a public hearing; Dunnington wants to know what we are doing on June 23rd, as that is our final meeting and we will have the response from the 3 state officials at that time. Landry asked if the final vote is a certain number of days after the public hearing.

Reynolds asked if following the public hearing, do we have to send it back to the state, Krans stated he believes so.
