Chairman Arthur J. DuBois called the regular meeting of the Planning Board to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, January 7, 1962, in the Board Office. On roll call there were seven members present.

The Board set the dates for the public hearings concerning the rezoning of the City. They are as follows: Jan. 28, Feb. 4, 11, 18 and 25.

Under new business, the Board took no action on the Sweatt revision of Strafford Woods pending further information and a letter of communication to be submitted with the revised plan. Also under new business, the Board acknowledged two applications for Planning Director; one from Mr. A. E. Suro of Owensville, Ohio, and one from Maurice Page of Akron, Ohio. The Board agreed to send a letter to Mr. Page, asking more information, and a letter to Mr. Suro telling him that the City's budgetary limitations make it impossible to meet the salary that he is now receiving.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
