

DOVER PLANNING BOARD
MINUTES OF MEETING

HELD: Monday, April 6, 1964
7:30 p.m.

ATTENDING: Vice-Chairman Hugh C. Tuttle, Secretary Robert W. Lapointe, Albert O. Bernard, Donald E. Chick, Raymond R. Ouellette, Robert T. Sheldon.

ALSO ATTENDING: Henry Neil, Planning Director.

Vice-Chairman Hugh C. Tuttle called the meeting of the Dover Planning Board to order at 8:40 p.m. on Monday, April 6, 1964 in the Planning Board Office.

The Planning Director then read aloud the proposed contract with the Ballard Company of Boston, Massachusetts. Discussion then followed upon the terms of the Board's contract. It was noted that in addition to the written report, the Planning Board will receive verbal advice under the terms of the Contract.

In answer to question by Mr. Lapointe, Mr. Chick noted that this Contract will be considered together with the Community Renewal Program Contract at the City Council Meeting on April 8, 1964.

Mr. Tuttle then outlined the history of the Community Renewal Program and the division of responsibility between the Planning Board and the City Council.

Motion made by Sheldon, seconded by Bernard that the proposed contract with the William H. Ballard Company of Boston, Massachusetts be approved and be submitted to the City Council with a recommendation for execution. Motion adopted unanimously.

The Vice-Chairman then called upon the Planning Director for the report on his conference with Mr. Bonkonski of the Housing and Home Finance Agency. The Planning Director did so and informed the Members of the various facts which had been revealed through this conference.

Some discussion arose upon the various aspects of urban renewal.

The Director then outlined to the Members the results of the meeting with Mr. J. Elbert Baril, State Planning Director, on possible Federal funds to assist in refining the Dover General Plan.

The Director then outlined the status of the present Dover General Plan pinpointing deficiencies in it and outlining the manner in which these deficiencies must be corrected.

Mr. Chick then recommended that as many Planning Board Members as possible attend the Regional Planning Meeting at the University of New Hampshire scheduled for April in 1964.


Mr. Neil and Mr. Chick outlined the history of the regional planning discussed thusfar.
