MINUTES OF MEETING

Chairman Akerman called the meeting of the Dover Planning Board to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, May 18, 1964 in the Planning Board Office.

Motion made by Bernard, seconded by Chick that the minutes of the previous meeting be accepted as written. Motion adopted unanimously.

Chairman Akerman then called upon the Planning Director to report on the current work of the Planning Board Office. The Planning Director did so, informing the Board that the Office was presently involved in the preparation of an economic base report and Capital Improvements Program, preparation of a Community Renewal Program, preliminary lay-out of a downtown urban renewal program and was representing the City in a regional planning organization. The Director also informed the Board that the Proposed Zoning Ordinance was expected to be passed by the City Council within the very near future.

Mr. Chick then informed the Board that a meeting between the School Committee and City Council to discuss the Proposed high school location was in progress in the School Committee room upstairs. Several members expressed interest in attending this meeting and the Planning Director was instructed to ask the School Committee Chairman if the Planning Board would be intruding by attending. The Committee Chairman had no objections.

Motion made by Lapointe, seconded by Bernard that the meeting be adjourned. Motion adopted unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 8 p.m.
