The Meeting of the Dover Planning Board was called to order at 7:40 p.m. in the Planning Board Office.

The Planning Director announced that a slide strip had been received from the National Retail Merchants Association which showed scenes from downtown areas throughout the country which had been renovated.

The Director then showed the site slides to the Members describing each of them. Some discussion then followed as to the familiarity between several of the slides and situations within the City of Dover.


Mr. Chick then excused himself for a Hospital Board Meeting.

The Planning Director then presented two pages of recommended amendments to the Dover Zoning Ordinance. Considerable discussion followed on the recommendations. Mr. Neil then reminded the Board of their earlier decision to receive these proposed amendments at one Meeting and either adopt or reject them at the following meeting in time to submit them to the City Council by the December 9 Meeting of the Council.

The Director then reported that 21 persons had visited the temporary Planning Office since its location in downtown Dover on Wednesday, November 18. He also informed the Board that the Dover Housing Authority had asked to meet with the Planning Director in the Board Office on Tuesday, November 24. It was agreed that Mr. Hugh C. Tuttle, as a representative of both the City Council and the Planning Board, would meet with the Housing Authority with Mr. Neil.

There being no further business, the Meeting was declared adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
