Chairman Lapointe called the Meeting of the Board to order at
7:40 p.m.

Mr. Link and Mr. LaBonte presented a request to the Board to
approve a turn-around at the end of Morin Street, and the necessary approval
under the Subdivision Regulations to enable them to move two houses from
Central Avenue and re-erect them on Morin Street.

Mr. Chick reviewed the problems involved presently in respect to
drainage on Morin Street and gave his opinion that approval of this request
would enable the City of Dover to at least partially correct these problems
as a by-product of the work to be done by the developers.

After explanation of the time element involved and the reasons
therefor, it was on Motion by Chick, seconded by DuBois, and unanimously
voted, that: The ten (10) day prior notice of submitting application
and plans in respect to a Subdivision be waived and the application be
considered at this time.

Motion by Chick, seconded by DuBois, and unanimously approved, that:

A Public Hearing be held on the Subdivision Application submitted by Mr. Link
and Mr. LaBonte, identified as Morin Street Extension, at 7:30 p.m. on Monday,
August 2, 1965 in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Motion by Sheldon, seconded by DuBois, that the Meeting be adjourned.

The Chairman declared the Meeting adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
