Chairman Lapointe called the Meeting of the Dover Planning Board to order at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, September 20, 1965.

The Board discussed the qualifications of Mr. Benjamin F. Howatt of Portland, Maine, candidate for the Office of Planning Director.

On motion by Akerman, seconded by Bardwell, a Committee of two be appointed consisting of Chairman Lapointe and Mr. Chick to enter into salary negotiations with Mr. Howatt. Motion adopted unanimously.

Motion by Bardwell, seconded by Akerman that the Committee be authorized to discuss salary within a range of \$8,500 to \$9,000, plus moving expenses, from Portland, Maine, to Dover, New Hampshire. Motion adopted unanimously.

Mr. Tuttle then brought the Board's attention to a referral from the City Council concerning City owned land at Fourth Street and Central Avenue.

Motion by Sheldon, seconded by Akerman, that it be recommended to the City Council that the land in question not be sold inasmuch as it presently appears that it will be needed for implementation of the City's future plans for development and improvement of the area involved. Motion adopted unanimously.

Motion by Akerman, seconded by Tuttle, that the Meeting be adjourned. The Meeting was adjourned at 8:36 p.m.
