

DOVER PLANNING BOARD
MINUTES OF MEETING

Chairman Lapointe called the Meeting of the Dover Planning Board
to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 10, 1966 in the Board Office.

Motion by Chick, seconded by Ouellette, that the minutes of the
previous meeting be accepted as written. Motion adopted unanimously.

Chairman Lapointe then noted the first item on the agenda was the
election of officers for 1966.

Motion by Sheldon, seconded by DuBois, that Mr. Lapointe be
re-elected as Chairman for 1966. Discussion with Chairman Lapointe indicated
that due to pressing business and the fact that he felt the Chairmanship should
be rotated amongst other members he wished to decline the nomination.

General discussion followed relating to the lack of a Planning
Director and the importance that the job of Chairman has in the absence of a
Director and that for purposes of continuity the present chairman would be
very valuable if he remained in the position.

It was then moved by DuBois, seconded by Tuttle, that nominations
be closed. Mr. Lapointe indicated that he would remain as Chairman for an
additional three month period.

Motion by Tuttle, seconded by DuBois, that Vice-Chairman Sheldon
be nominated as Vice-Chairman of the Board for 1966.

Motion by Chick, seconded by Tuttle that nominations be closed.
It was voted that the Secretary cast one ballot.

Motion by Chick, seconded by DuBois, that Secretary Ouellette
be nominated as Secretary of the Board for 1966.

Motion by Sheldon, seconded by Tuttle that nominations be closed.
It was voted that the Secretary cast one ballot.

A brief discussion then followed concerning the setting up of goals for 1966. Mr. Sheldon stated that he felt the only goal at this time was that of obtaining a Planning Director after which additional 1966 goals could be discussed.

Under old business the letters drafted by the Committee to obtain a Planning Director was discussed and it was decided that a change should be made relating to the salary range.


Also under old business Mr. Lapointe reported to the Board that a sign had been erected at the entrance of Industrial Park.

The Housing and Building Inspector Mr. McDonald then discussed several points concerning the zoning ordinance and made recommendations in general. Mr. DuBois suggested that Mr. McDonald list all the areas in question on a sheet of paper and submit it to the Board by their next meeting. Mr. McDonald agreed to do this.

Motion by DuBois, Seconded by Bardwell that the Meeting be adjourned. Motion adopted unanimously.
