his education.


It was decided that the Board would discuss the matter at their

Mr. Clarence E. Chase who spoke on the need for new industrial zoning. Taking
part in this discussion was Mr. Stuart N. Shaines and Mr. Fred Easter of the
Economic Commission. A lengthy discussion concerning industrial zoning followed.

at 9:30 p.m.
