MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

The Meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 30, 1966 in the Planning Board Office.

On motion by Tuttle, seconded by Ouellette, Mr. Bernard was appointed as Acting Chairman. On roll call the following members were present: Acting Chairman Bernard, Secretary Ouellette, Donald E. Chick, Arthur J. DuBois Charles E. Prescott and Hugh C. Tuttle. Also attending were: Planning Director William R. Chandler and Public Works Director Harry N. Griffin.

ITEM NO. 2: REVIEW OF PROPOSED MINIMUM STANDARDS OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT:

The Planning Director reviewed the status of the proposed amendment to the powers and duties of the Planning Board. The amendment had its first reading in the Council and has been referred to a Council Committee of the Whole. The Planning Director and the City Attorney have reviewed all of the existing statutes governing planning boards and it was their joint feeling that the City ordinance should be updated to conform with the State Statutes. This would mean several amendments to the Planning Board Enabling Ordinance. The Planning Director then reviewed all of the proposed amendments with the Board. A lengthy discussion ensued weighing the merits of each amendment. The Board agreed to postpone any action until its regular meeting on Dec. 5.

ITEM NO. 3: OTHER BUSINESS.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
