

DOVER PLANNING BOARD
MINUTES OF MEETING
SPECIAL

The Special Planning Board Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 23, 1967 in the Planning Board Office. The Chair appointed Member Ouellette as Acting Secretary until the regular Secretary Akerman arrived.

The following members were present: Chairman Sheldon, Vice-Chairman Ouellette, Secretary Akerman, Members Bernard, Chick, DuBois, Lapointe, Prescott, Tuttle. Also in attendance were Planning Director Chandler, Public Works Director Griffin and Economic Director Chase and Bob Varney, City Hall Reporter from Foster's Daily Democrat.

ITEM NO. 2: REFERRAL BY CITY COUNCIL TO PLANNING BOARD OF COMMUNICATION FROM SAMUEL A. TAMPOSI, REALTOR, REQUESTING THAT PARCEL 2 ON ASSESSOR'S SHEET D BE REZONED TO A B-3 DISTRICT:

It was moved by Chick, seconded by Ouellette, that the Dover Planning Board hold a public meeting on this item at 8:00 p.m. on Feb. 6, 1967, at the Horne Street School, if possible, or in the alternative, the City Hall Auditorium. Unanimously approved.

It was moved by Chick, seconded by Ouellette that letters of notification of said public meeting be sent to the property owners of record on Whittier Street from Glenwood Avenue to Sixth Street Glenwood from Central Avenue to the Turnpike and on Barry Street and Smith Well Road. Unanimously approved.

Mayor Tuttle, Economic Director Chase and Planning Director Chandler agreed to meet with a representative of the Tamposi Association to study possible access roads to the connector road.

ITEM NO. 3: NEW BUSINESS:

a. It was moved by DuBois, seconded by Akerman, that the Planning Director be allowed to attend the Belknap County Conference on Beautification on Jan. 24 and 25, 1967, in Laconia, New Hampshire. Unanimously approved.

b. Extension course at the University of New Hampshire for Planning Director.

It was moved by Chick, seconded by Bernard, to authorize the Planning Director to take a course on economics of Resources Development in the Spring Semester and to pay tuition and textbook costs.

c. February 1 Meeting of New Hampshire Natural Resources Council.

The Board authorized the Planning Director and as many Members of the Board that could make it to attend the Meeting in Concord.

There being no further new business, it was moved by DuBois, seconded by Lapointe to adjourn. Unanimously approved.
