

DOVER PLANNING BOARD
MINUTES OF MEETING
SPECIAL

The Meeting of the Dover Planning Board was called to order by Chairman Sheldon at 4:30 p.m. in the Planning Board Office on Monday, Jan. 30, 1967.

On roll call, the following members were present: Chairman Sheldon, Vice-Chairman Ouellette, Secretary Akerman, Members Chick, DuBois, Lapointe, Prescott and Tuttle. Also attending was Planning Director Chandler and Public Works Director Griffin.

The Planning Director displayed maps of the area of land in question with overlays to point out zoning districts and utilities.

After lengthy discussion by the Board it was moved by Tuttle, seconded by Lapointe that the Dover Planning Board recommend to the City Council that (1) The water main be extended down Knox Marsh Road, pursuant to the existing ordinances, and brought in under the road or through the culvert to reach this land. The motion was adopted with Mr. Prescott and Mr. Chick voting in the negative.

The Board then discussed possible roads in and around the enlarged industrial area. It was agreed by the Board to postpone further discussion until the regular Board Meeting on Feb. 6 and to meet with a representative of the developer and the Economic Director at that time.

The Meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
