1. ROLL CALL

2. ELECTION OF MAYOR PRO TEM

Tweedie moved seconded by Whitmore to appoint Dunnington as Mayor Pro Tem. Motion passed 8-0 on a roll call vote.

3. ADOPTION OF 2003 COUNCIL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Tweedie moved to adopt the proposed rules and regulations for 2003. Quigley moved to amend item #12-A to read: All speakers shall be residents of Dover, property owners in the City of Dover and/or business owners in the City of Dover.
